	Operations Manager Role  NC is on the interview panel. The first round of shortlisting has taken place with 42 applications made so far. NC has picked out 8 or 9 for his shortlist. The first round of interviews will be on 30th April with the interview panel consisting of Clea Warner (CW), NC, Willy Inglis (WI) and James Dean (JD). The second round of interviews will take place on 17th May. Candidates will come out to Canna for a visit between the two interviews.

7.Canna Partnership update	Change House Barn - quote for the remedial works came in at £150,000. NTS want to carry out an "Historic Impact Assessment" on the barn. The building is in danger of collapse and the heras fencing will do little to mitigate the effect of the collapse. If the roof comes down then the walls will fall outwards. 	<b>Farm Succession</b> - Splitting the farm to have a tenant farm at <b>Tarbert</b> . <b>NTS</b> are having a meeting to discuss it however it would be better to have <b>GMK</b> included in that meeting as she has the know how. <b>NTS</b> would not have to pay an extra farm manager as it would be a tenant farm.	
	Farm Succession - There was a discussion about the farm, the NTS, concerns about rewilding. Jeff Waddell, NTS Conservation, has said that Canna must always be farmed and interlinked with conservation, but what does this actually mean? CW stated that rewilding was not being considered. SL is meant to be emailing GMK and MW with an update on farm progress. Consideration should be given to how much work the farm team does around Canna.	MW to follow up with SL on farm update email.
